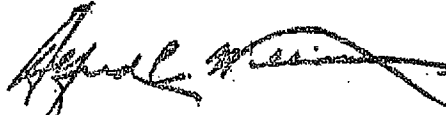

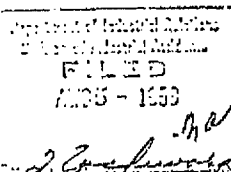

FINDINGS AND AWARD



An Application having been filed herein, all parties having appeared, and the matter having been regularly heard before Olney L. Huff, Referee, and submitted for decision, said Referee now makes his Findings and Award as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Allen Everitt, born March 7, 1900, sustained an injury arising out of and occurring in the course of his employment, consisting of asbestosis caused by his exposure to asbestos while in the employ of Western Asbestos Company for the period 1946 to March 1, 1963, as an asbestos worker. At said time the employer's insurance carrier was State Compensation Insurance Fund.

2. Said injury caused temporary total disability beginning May 1, 1963, to and including August 1, 1963, and continuing, entitling applicant to compensation during said period at the rate of \$70.00 a week, based upon maximum earnings.

3. The evidence is insufficient to indicate apportionment.

4. Applicant is in need of further medical treatment to cure or relieve from the effects of the injury herein.

5. Applicant has incurred the expense of a medical report from W. R. Brode, M. D., in the sum of \$15.00, and the expense of examination, report, x-rays and laboratory tests from Joseph Ross, M. D., in the sum of \$112.50, necessary to successfully prove his

1 claim and is entitled to be reimbursed for the same, payment of
2 \$15.00 to be made to Dr. Brode, and \$112.50 to Dr. Ross.

3 6. Applicant is entitled to reimbursement for self-pro-
4 cured medical treatment, the matter to be adjusted by the parties.

5 7. The Department of Employment has paid unemployment
6 compensation disability benefits and is entitled to a lien against
7 unpaid compensation at the rate of \$70.00 a week for the period
8 beginning May 1, 1963, to and including July 14, 1963.

9 8. Defendants were not prejudiced through lack of notice.

10 9. The injury herein was caused by applicant's employment
11 on land and the Commission has jurisdiction of the case.

12 10. Applicant became disabled and first had knowledge that
13 his disability was the result of his employment within one year
14 prior to the filing of the application for compensation benefits and
15 the claim is not barred by the statute of limitations.

16 11. Applicant's attorneys, Smith, Parrish, Paduck & Clancy,
17 have performed legal services of the reasonable value of \$75.00 and
18 are entitled to a lien in said amount against unpaid compensation
19 which is to take priority of the lien claim of the Department of
20 Employment.

21 A W A R D

22 AWARD IS MADE in favor of ALLEN EVERITT against STATE
23 COMPENSATION INSURANCE FUND of temporary disability indemnity at the
24 rate of \$70.00 a week beginning May 1, 1963, to and including
25 August 1, 1963, and indefinitely thereafter, until the further order
26 of this Commission, less the sum of \$75.00 payable to Smith, Parrish,
27 Paduck and Clancy as an attorneys' fee, and less the lien of the
28 Department of Employment at the rate of \$70.00 a week for the period
29 beginning May 1, 1963, to and including July 14, 1963.

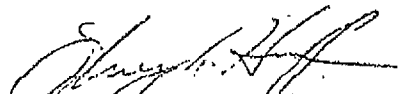

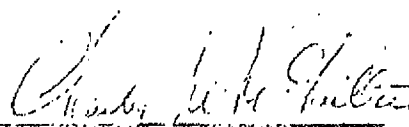

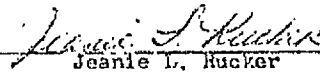

He has had no clerical training.

He drove to Dr. Griffecath. He can make short trips driving. He can't sit too long. When he walks a block and a half he has to stop and rest because he has shortness of breath.

DISPOSITION:

Within the discretion of the Referee case to be referred to the Permanent Disability Rating Bureau; seven days to the parties for rebuttal of its report. Case otherwise submitted.

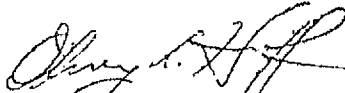
