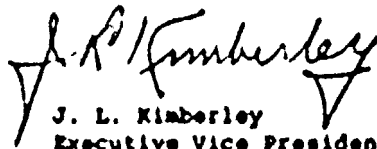
Pennsylvania Air Pollution Control Commission Action and Notice of Meeting

As announced in Don Fowler's letter of November 15, 1966, there will be a meeting of the Pennsylvania members of the Lead Industries Association at 10:00 A.M., Friday, December 9, 1966 at the Association's headquarters, 14th floor, 292 Madison Avenue, New York, N.Y.

The primary purpose of the meeting will be to discuss the course of action to be taken by the LIA and its Pennsylvania members as a result of the acceptance for public hearing by the Pennsylvania Air Pollution Control Commission of an ambient air quality criterion for lead of 5 micrograms per cubic meter of air averaged over a 30-day period.
