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3 On some occasions, the name Abex or American Brakeblok
4 may have been printed in black or white on the edge or underside
5 of certain brake lining products.

6 (e) Abex does not possess sufficient knowledge
7 concerning the total amount of raw asbestos purchased or subse-
8 quently incorporated into the asbestos-containing automotive
9 friction products manufactured by it. Abex is generally aware
10 that chrysotile asbestos fiber was purchased from the following
11 companies at various periods during the years 1950-present:

26 (g),(h) All asbestos-containing friction prod-
27 ucts manufactured and sold by Abex were generally packaged in
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
