3 A This is part of his occupational history.

4 Q Did you review that back sometime in
5 February of this year?

6 A You have asked me when I got it. I have
7 already answered it. I don't remember.

8 Q Sorry about that.

9 From approximately 1950 to 1975 he worked in
10 and around the Baltimore, Maryland area.

11 While a member of the Plasterers Local 155
12 in Baltimore, Maryland, Mr. Vandergucht's asbestos
13 exposure included spray asbestos fireproofing
14 material.

15 Now, if he was exposed to that, would that
16 be a cause of the mesothelioma that he suffered from?

17 A Any and all exposure to asbestos that Mr.
18 Vandergucht had.

19 Those listed here and those not listed here
20 that were occupational were substantial contributing
21 factors to his developing a mesothelioma.
