- 1) Has EPA determined whether Chemours has violated the terms of the 2009 consent order issued under the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) for the production of GenX?
- 2) Has EPA determined whether there have been any other violations by Chemours?
- 3) Has EPA updated the risk assessment for GenX?
