As a result of requests for production and discussion of those requests in Court in Charleston, West Virginia, Pittsburgh Corning Corporation has caused a further review of documents which came from its files and which counsel for plaintiffs might argue relate to knowledge on the part of Pittsburgh Corning Corporation of health hazards caused by exposure to asbestos. The search was done for the entire period of time in which Pittsburgh Corning Corporation manufactured Unibestos and was geared to identify documents which may not have been previously produced to your firm or its affiliated counsel. It is our belief that in the discovery over the years that your firm or its affiliated counsel have seen virtually every document which came from Pittsburgh Corning Corporation's files and which would fall into the above description.
