Attached is a map to my office. Georgia Tech has a number of streets closed off due to Olympic construction, so the way in is a bit convoluted.

Exit I-85 at 10th Street. Take a right onto 10th, and your first right onto Spring. You will be heading south towards downtown. Take a right onto Fifth (second light). Fifth will cross over the highway. At the first light, take a left onto Techwood. Take your first right onto Campus Drive. Go past Fowler (which is under heavy construction). You will be passing a number of fraternities and sororities. The first institutional building on your right is the Architecture Building. It has a new wing (concrete) and an old wing (brick). There is a parking lot in front of it.

At the gate, dial 000 and tell the guard that you are visiting me. Park and enter the concrete building through the courtyard that is located between the two wings.

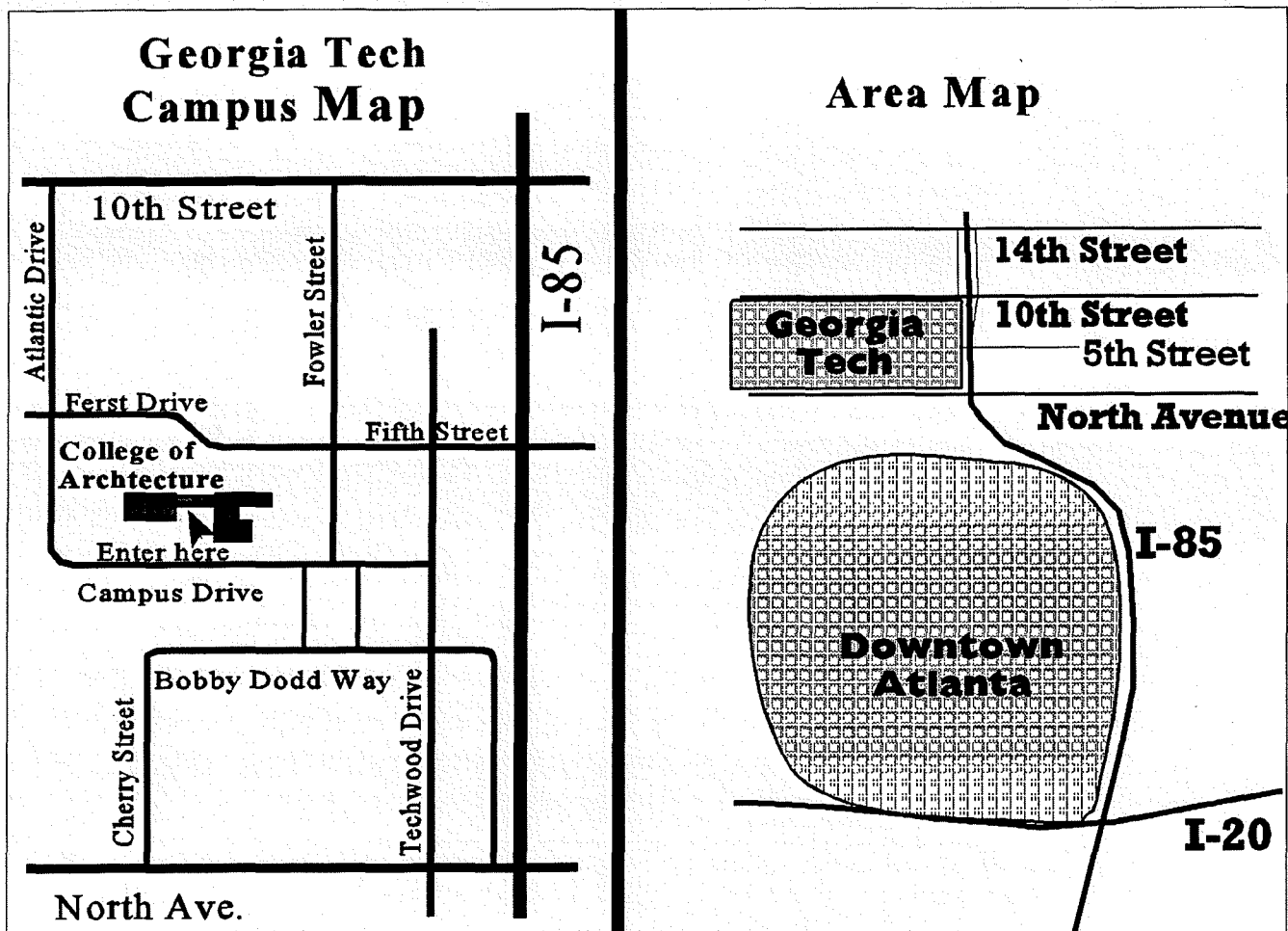
