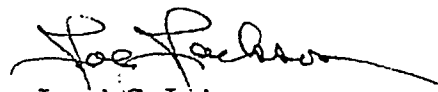

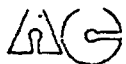

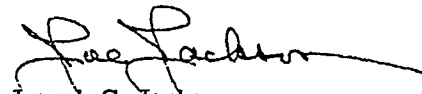

Your presentation should be formal in tone, 20 minutes in length and, where appropriate, supplemented by graphics or handout materials. Please give him a call to clear up an uncertainty or misgiving you might have relative to the scope and substance of your presentation. Lastly, we request that a copy of your personal remarks be submitted to AACPP Counsel no later than April 23, 1982.
