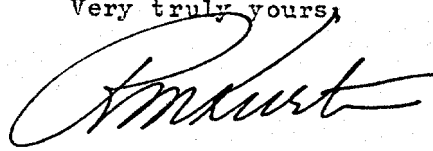

I am sending you herewith a report of analyses made on the urine and blood of [REDACTED]. These are indicative of some degree of lead exposure. The blood level is only slightly above the normal, but the urinary value is considerably elevated.
