WITNESS In consideration of the mutual promises herein made, Owner and Contractor agree as follows:

ARTICLE 1 — THE WORK: The work shall consist of: Plant maintenance, construction, hot tap service, and equipment rental as requested by Owner.

Contractor shall perform all work hereunder in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Contract and the following as noted:

This Agreement, including Articles 1 through 8, the Field Services General Terms and Conditions on the reverse side hereof, and the Exhibits attached hereto or referenced herein shall constitute the Contract between the parties.

ARTICLE 2 — MATERIALS, PERSONNEL AND SUBCONTRACTS: Contractor shall furnish any and all labor, supervision, permits (unless otherwise stated herein to the contrary), machinery, equipment, tools, fuel, supplies, facilities, materials, transportation and all other things necessary for the performance and completion of all work authorized hereunder, except such items noted to be specifically supplied by Owner as follows:

As applicable

Unless, otherwise specified, all materials to be furnished by Contractor shall be new and of a grade and quality which conforms to Owner's Standards, if such apply; otherwise such material must be suitable for the use intended.

ARTICLE 3 — COMPENSATION: For satisfactory performance of the work hereunder, Owner agrees to pay Contractor in the manner and at times hereinafter specified, and Contractor agrees to accept as full and complete payment for providing such work, compensation as follows:

ARTICLE 4 — MANNER AND TIMES OF PAYMENT:

Invoicing shall be monthly with supporting documents attached.

Terms: Net 30

Prior to final payment hereunder, and as a condition thereto, Contractor shall satisfy the requirements of Clause 14 of the Field Services General Terms and Conditions on the reverse side hereof.

ARTICLE 5 — TERM: Work under this Contract shall commence on or about Aug. 1, 1980. All work performed at the site shall be on the basis of Contractor's standard work week as set forth by local agreement. No overtime shall be worked, except for spot overtime, unless approved by the Owner in writing. All work, including testing shall be complete on or before until cancelled by either party with 15 days written notice.

ARTICLE 6 — CHANGES, ADDITIONS AND/OR DELETIONS: Owner reserves the right, from time to time, to make changes, additions and/or deletions to the work as it may deem necessary. All changes, additions or deletions shall be made in writing and accepted by both parties before Contractor proceeds with such work. Contractor shall make no changes, additions or deletions to the work without Owner's prior written instructions. The cost of such changes, additions or deletions shall be determined as follows: As negotiated. Any changes in rates must be submitted in writing thirty (30) days prior to effective date.

Contractor shall make no changes in the Schedule of work to be performed hereunder, extending completion beyond the date shown in Article 5 above, without prior written approval of Owner.

ARTICLE 7 — INSURANCE: During the performance of all work hereunder, Contractor shall take out, carry and maintain in insurance company or companies, and in policies of insurance acceptable to Owner, the following insurance with limits not less than indicated for the respective items:

- Workmen's Compensation and Occupational Disease Insurance, including Employer's Liability, complying with laws of the state in which the work is to be performed or elsewhere as may be required. Employer's Liability Insurance shall be provided with a limit not less than \$100,000.00
- Comprehensive General Liability Insurance, including Contractual Liability and Products-Completed Operations Liability and Explosion, Collapse and Underground Damage liability, as well as coverage on all Contractor's equipment (other than motor vehicles licensed for highway use) owned, hired or used in performance of this contract with limits not less than: \$1,000,000.00 bodily injury & property damage combined each occurrence and aggregate
- Automobile Liability Insurance, including Contractual Liability, covering all motor vehicles owned, hired or used in the performance of this contract, with limits not less than: \$1,000,000.00 bodily injury & property damage combined each occurrence and aggregate
- Builders Risk Insurance: The Builders Risk Insurance coverage applicable to this contract is checked below. For definition of applicable coverage see Clause 22 of Field Services General Terms and Conditions on the reverse side of this form. 1. ☐ N/A 2. ☐

The pay period begins at 12:01 a.m. Monday morning and ends at 12:00 p.m. Sunday night. The standard work day shall be 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Personnel required to work other than these hours will be charged at the overtime rate unless other arrangements are made prior to commencing work.

- * Travel time one way shall be paid each employee from REFINERY MAINTENANCE COMPANY yard, or from such location as designated by REFINERY MAINTENANCE COMPANY, accessible by private auto within the city limits of Corpus Christi. Travel time will be charged to the customer. Travel time will be overtime unless employee works less than eight (8) hours per day including travel time. If distance or other conditions prohibit traveling to and from the job, the crew will be required to stay overnight. The customer will be charged \$35.00 per night per man for crew members and \$40.00 per night per supervisor.

All hours worked in excess of eight (8) hours per shift, and in excess of forty (40) hours per week, are charged at the overtime rate.

Holidays to be observed by field forces will be the same as those observed by the customer. Employees of REFINERY MAINTENANCE COMPANY required to work on holidays will be charged at the overtime rate.

Rates for labor quoted above are in effect at this time. Any increase in taxes or regulated insurance rates for Workmen's Compensation will result in appropriate additional billing.

No increases in billing due to increase in wages will be billed without prior submission of increases for approval.

Small tools are described as hand tools used by the crafts to perform regular work, costing less than \$300.00 to purchase.

The pay period begins at 12:01 a.m. Monday morning and ends at 12:00 p.m. Sunday night. The standard work day shall be 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Personnel required to work other than these hours will be charged at the overtime rate unless other arrangements are made prior to commencing work. Employees who are called out to work at times other than their normal shift will be charged a minimum of four (4) hours.

Travel time shall be charged to the customer from the GOLDSTON CORPORATION yard, or from such location as designated by GOLDSTON CORPORATION. Travel time shall be charged one way only unless the employee works less than eight (8) hours, including travel time, in which case, travel time will be charged both ways. Travel time will be overtime unless employee works less than eight (8) hours per day including travel time. If distance or other conditions prohibit traveling to and from the job, the crew will be required to stay overnight. The customer will be charged \$40.00 per night per man for crew members and \$50.00 per night per supervisor.

All hours worked in excess of eight (8) hours per shift, and in excess of forty (40) hours per week, are charged at the overtime rate.

If the employee is required to work more than twelve (12) hours on the job site, overtime meals will be furnished and charged to the customer's account at cost plus ten percent (10%).

Holidays to be observed by GOLDSTON CORPORATION will be as follows:

New Years Day	Thanksgiving Day
Memorial Day	Friday after Thanksgiving Day
Independence Day	Christmas Day
Labor Day	Floating Holiday

In addition, we will include any holidays observed by customer. Employees of GOLDSTON CORPORATION required to work on holidays will be charged at the overtime rate.

Small tool charges are included in the rate shown and will not be billed separately. Small tools are described as non-motorized hand tools used by the crafts to perform regular work, costing less than \$300.00 to purchase.

Special tools, if required, will be furnished along with materials and expendable supplies at cost plus ten percent (10%).

Losses of, or damages to any equipment or other property belonging to the Contractor which is not compensated by Contractor's insurance, provided such losses or damages are the result of cause other than the fault or neglect of the Contractor, shall be paid for by the Owner at cost plus five percent (5%).
