Hi Nick,

Glad to work with you to add energy elements to this analysis if helpful. I am attaching the draft of our longer list of related activities and programs initiated since 2009. These activities are the result of needs identified as early as 2008. We felt it was important to identify and chronical our work in addressing environmental change and risks from climate to forest and grasslands. Most of these activities are not the direct result of the E.O.s and Memorandums that were revoked but part of our work to address climate related risks.
