Dear Mr. Russell:

Enclosed herewith is copy of Memorandum of Agreement signed by the various manufacturers who underwrote the Saranac Laboratory experiments. Since three of the signers limited their contributions to \$250 per annum, the remainder contributed \$666.67 annually for the three years 1937, 1938, and 1939. Some of the companies financed the experiments for another year or two but your Company's contributions were limited to the three years referred to above and aggregated, therefore, a total of \$2,000.

The foregoing is based on a hasty check of our records but I believe it is accurate, and I trust it will serve your purpose.

It is not contemplated that the experiments will be continued at this time nor does the meeting concern itself with further contributions. The matter we want to decide is whether and to what extent the results of the experiments should be made public.
