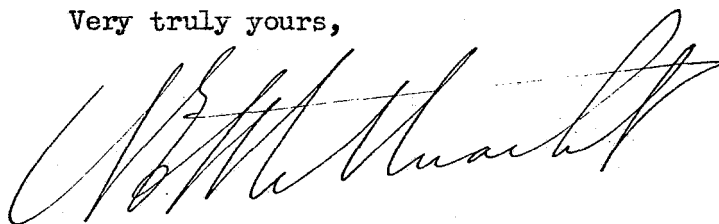

During the recent meeting of the Fourth Annual Greater New York Safety Conference a few of the safety representatives from the petroleum companies in this section met to discuss certain problems of mutual interest.

During this informal meeting the subject was raised concerning topics to be presented before the meeting of the National Safety Council this fall.
