

1 This included materials such as quick and
2 hydrated lime, various sources of diatomaceous earth,
3 natural diatomaceous earth as opposed to calcine
4 diatomaceous earth, clay, amosite, chrysotile
5 asbestos, various finenesses of silica flour.

6 Q And where were those duties performed that
7 you described?

8 A In the Berlin plant.

9 Q Again, what products were made there at that
10 point in time?

11 A The Berlin plant at that point in time
12 produced a mix line of pipecovering, insulating block,
13 fireproof door core material, and some experimental
14 batches of roof tile.

15 Q Now, which, if any, of those products
16 contained asbestos?

17 A They all contained asbestos.

18 Q And what type of asbestos was that?

19 A It varied from time to time, but typically
20 all of the products contained both chrysotile and
21 amosite asbestos.
