RESPIRATORS

There are set locations in this department where approved type respirators must be worn if we are to comply with recommendations of the State Department of Labor. By approved type respirators I mean the ones that have the cloth filters on the sides. Such respirators are to be worn at the following places:

1. By both mixer man and his helper only when making up mixes or mixing fibre, etc.
2. At end trim take-off from Block Millier. For example - when we are making segments or full size blocks ^{for} profile gang saw.
3. When doing any sagging or any kind in the Dust House.

Mr. Danaher has advised me that he expects the Department of Labor to visit us again shortly.
