5. THIS WAS BROUGHT TO MY ATTENTION DURING THE AUDIT. I TALKED WITH THE B&R FOREMAN ABOUT THE ISSUE. AS IT TURNED OUT, THERE WAS NO PROBLEM HERE. B&R WAS ADHEREING TO ALL ASBESTOS HANDLING REQUIREMENTS. IN AN ASBESTOS AREA, THERE ARE ACTUALLY TWO BARRICADED AREAS; ONE FOR ACTUAL ASBESTOS REMOVAL (RESPIRATORS REQUIRED); THE OTHER AS A DECONTAMINATION AREA WHERE DRINKING WATER IS AVAILABLE, COVERALLS REMOVED, ETC (RESPIRATORS ARE NOT REQUIRED IN THIS AREA). THIS WAS BROUGHT TO THE ATTENTION OF THE AUDIT GROUP DURING THE AUDIT.
