Gentlemen:

TEXACO's El Paso Plant has planned renovations due to routine inspection and test of operating units throughout the period from June 1, 1982 to December 31, 1982. During this period the normal maintenance and repair of machinery and equipment may result in the removal of friable asbestos insulation in excess of 260 feet of pipe and/or 160 square feet of surface of ducts, tanks, turbines, etc. All replacement insulation will be of a non-asbestos type. Especially large projects will be served by individual notification.

In accordance with the National Emission Standards for asbestos, published in the Federal Register 40 CFR 61 dated October 4, 1975, the attached information is furnished as our written notification to carry out this work.

As resulting from (a) above which collectively may be in excess of 260 ft. of pipe and/or 160 sq. ft. of surface of ducts, tanks, turbines, etc. All replacement insulation will be of a non-asbestos type.

El Paso Plant is located at 6500 Trowbridge Avenue, in the City of El Paso, El Paso County, Texas.

5. Scheduled Starting and Completion Dates of Renovation:

6. Type of Renovation:

Stripping and/or removal of insulation material that may contain asbestos as required to effectuate required and necessary scheduled and emergency inspections, maintenance, and repairs to various operating units, associated machinery, piping and equipment.

Insulation that may contain asbestos is removed and disposed of according to the requirements of this regulation, Section 61.22, paragraphs (d) and (g) and existing Texas and OSHA standards.
