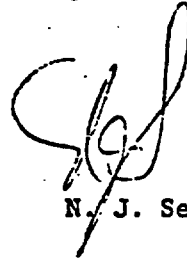

Despite improvement in sales to the paper industry and in Resin-Grade August domestic business was at July level. Sales were sharply down to flooring accounts -- only \$2M against a monthly average of \$26M. Return to normal is expected in September.

The paper industry accounted for 50% of total domestic sales -- the best month in some time. Initial carload sales of T-135 to Westvaco is largely responsible. This business should be firm on an every other month basis.

Resin-Grade sales were improved by new business at Major Paint for a developmental rutile TiO₂ asbestos product and sizeable reorders for R-G 244 from American Petrochemical, Dunnage Engineering and Ohio Sealer.
