Dear Mr. Secretary:

On January 30, 1943, the Board of Economic Warfare, by Mr. Willard Wirts, approved the contract entered into on behalf of Metals Reserve Company, by its Special Representative, Mr. William Stix Wasserman, with Raw Asbestos Distributors, Ltd., Spotland, Rochdale, Lancashire, England, dated December 18, 1942, for the purchase of a total of 33,470 short tons of grades 1, 2, 3 and 4 chrysotile asbestos from South Africa or Rhodesia, under the terms and conditions of said contract, a copy of which was submitted to the board of Economic Warfare on January 30, 1943. This approval is hereby confirmed.

This contract includes the quantities of asbestos covered by the proposed contract previously authorized by the Board of Economic Warfare by Directive No. 1123, dated January 5, 1943.
