NOTIFICATION OF DELEGATION OF NSPS/NESHAPS

TO THE TEXAS AIR CONTROL BOARD

On November 15, 1978, the Regional Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region 6 approved delegation of the New Source Performance Standards (NSPS) and the National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAPS) to the State of Texas. The State of Texas and the Texas Air Control Board now have the primary responsibility for implementing and enforcing the presently promulgated NSPS and NESHAPS standards and requirements in the State of Texas.

Our records show that one or more units at your plant(s) located in Texas are subject to NSPS, 40 CFR Part 60, and/or NESHAPS, 40 CFR Part 61. Effective immediately, everything required to be submitted, pursuant to present NSPS and NESHAPS regulations, should now be sent in duplicate to the Texas Air Control Board instead of EPA Region 6.
