SPECIFIC COMMODITY RATES

Cancels Item 1000

(In dollars per truckload)

Titanium dioxide, in bags or pails, ~~between Baton Rouge, Mississippi and the Mississippi State Port Authority facilities, Gulfport, Mississippi~~, restricted to shipments having a prior or subsequent movement by water in foreign commerce: 1-4 shipments tendered in a day - \$64.00 each; 5 shipments tendered in a day - \$55.00 each; 6 or more shipments tendered in a day - \$50.00 each.

ITEM 1005-A [3]

SPECIFIC COMMODITY RATES

Titanium dioxide, chemicals, rubber and plastic products, in bags, pails or packages, in 20 or 40 foot length steamship containers, 50,000 pounds maximum weight.

1. From Harrison County, Mississippi to New Orleans, Louisiana - \$184.00 per trip.
2. In situations when the carrier is dispatched without a loaded container from Harrison County, Mississippi to the Port of New Orleans, Louisiana, for the purpose of retrieving and returning an empty container for movement from the Port of New Orleans, Louisiana to Harrison County, Mississippi - the charge of \$140.00 will be assessed.

ITEM 1010-A * *

SPECIFIC COMMODITY RATES

Cancels Item 1010

Titanium dioxide, chemicals, rubber and plastic articles, in bags, pails or packages.

1. Between Harrison County, Mississippi and Panama City, Florida, 42,000 pounds minimum weight - the rate of 85 cents cwt.
2. Empty ocean containers, used in prior or subsequent movement by water in (1) above - the rate of 85 cents per mile.

ITEM 1015-A [3]

SPECIFIC COMMODITY RATES

Chemicals and related products, 48,000 pounds maximum weight per truckload.

From Baton Rouge and Plaquemine, Louisiana, to Mississippi State Port Authority facilities, Gulfport, Mississippi - the charge of \$375.00 per truckload.
