This product contains asbestos fibers. Inhalation of asbestos fibers in excessive quantities over long periods of time may be harmful. Avoid breathing the dust. If adequate ventilation control is not possible, wear respirators of a type approved by the U.S. Bureau of Mines for pneumoconiosis protecting dusts.

Dr. L. H. H. Jr. said that the label is applied to each package, pallet, or to the label rather than each board.

WARNING

This product contains asbestos fibers. Inhalation of asbestos fibers in excessive quantities over long periods of time may be harmful. Avoid breathing the dust. If adequate ventilation control is not possible, wear respirators of a type approved by the U.S. Bureau of Mines for pneumoconiosis producing dusts.
