Subject: Industrial Hygiene Survey

The attached report describing an industrial hygiene survey in Batavia Transmission Plant gives recommendations for control of employee exposures to oil mist. Implementation of these or equally effective control measures is essential to:

- . Assure conservation of employee health
- . Adhere to Company directives regarding occupational health issues
- . Comply with OSHA regulations and standards
- . Meet UAW contractual agreements regarding employee health and safety

Survey recommendations are summarized:

- . Implement respiratory protection program for employees overexposed to oil mist. Such a program must comply with OSHA regulations and Industrial Hygiene and Toxicology Department directives.
- . Improve ventilation at Cincinnati grinders to control employee exposures to oil mist.

Your response to me by June 26, 1981 with a plan including a timetable to implement the specific recommendations in Attachment I will be appreciated.
