This is to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of June 15, with the attached correspondence with Sergeant Oscar P. Cohen.

I have received a letter from Sergeant Cohen, asking for information about tetraethyl lead, and I have sent him all of the information we have. I also urged him to come to visit us and suggested as tactfully as I could that I consider any additional toxicologic work somewhat unnecessary. For a number of reasons I thought it was worth while to try to discourage additional experimental work, and although I may not succeed, it seemed worth a trial.
