Michelle: I hope all is well. I have the pleasure of forwarding the attached invitation to Administrator Pruitt to address the senior executives of the Glass Packaging Institute—which represents the domestic glass industry, including three glass plants in Oklahoma—sometime convenient to him between 8 am and 9:30 am on Wednesday May 3 at the Monocle on the Senate side of the Hill.
