In response to your inquiry, I am enclosing a breakdown of phases of research conducted by the CMA Vinyl Chloride Project Panel. Our records show that Certain-Teed Products, Corp. participated in all seven phases of the research program, the first of which was initiated in February 1973. "Participation" means that your company provided financial support for the project through a written commitment (a sample of which is also enclosed) and appointed a Panel member.
