My Dear Sir:-

We have made another test of the Dahl lead, and in this test we find that the paint made with it is entirely satisfactory.

We have further examined some of the lead that we have on hand, and find a great variation in it: some of it being very poor in color and lacking in body, while the rest is all right. The first test that was made must have been made with a barrel of lead that was very poor. For this last test, I had the same barrel of lead used that was used for making the test in paste form a short time ago. If the lead could be furnished uniform like this barrel, it no doubt would be very well, if not, it would be of little or no value.
