TO: MEMBERS OF THE VINYL CHLORIDE SAFETY ASSOCIATION

A number of members have expressed interest in holding a one day meeting of the association in mid-April, 1975 to discuss current concerns of member companies relating to the Occupational Safety and Health Administration permanent standards for worker exposure to vinyl chloride and pending Environmental Protection Agency regulations for VCM emissions.
