(*Footnote. After the death of Dr. Leroy U. Gardner, October 24, 1946, there was found among his papers a manuscript apparently prepared for publication to conclude the experimental studies of Dr. Gardner and his late associate, Donald E. Cummings, where were begun in January, 1928. Also was found an incomplete "Outline of (a) Proposed Monograph on Asbestosis", (a) "Saranac Laboratory Study under Grant from Asbestos Association".

This outline included two parts, "Part I, Human Asbestosis" and "Part II, Experimental Asbestosis".

Part I was only in topic form. Part II, however, really constitutes a valuable summary presentation of the long time Saranac studies in asbestosis.

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No changes have been made in the body of these manuscripts and they are joined into one, as a final report of Dr. Gardners outstanding work.

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
