We are pleased to submit our proposal for painting the above-referenced project in Conoco's VCM Plant in Lake Charles, Louisiana.

SCOPE OF WORK:

- (1) Two tanks
- (2) Two pumps and motors
- (3) Piping and valves to existing piping
- (4) Structure
- (5) Platform and ladder

SPECIFICATIONS:

- (1) Sandblast to SSPC-SP #6.
- (2) Apply two coats of primer.
- (3) Apply two coats of finish.

PRICE: FOUR THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$4,250.00)

NOTE: Deduct \$250.00 if Conoco furnishes sandblasting sand.

GENERAL NOTES:

- (1) This proposal will remain firm for 30 days and is based upon all painting work being completed prior to June 30, 1973.
- (2) Spent sandblasting sand shall be put in waste cans provided at the site by Conoco and removed when filled by others.
- (3) Slone will put a curtain between the tanks and the waste pits to circumvent large amounts of sand from entering the ponds. Any protection in addition to this is not included in this proposal.

- (4) Slone Industrial Painters will furnish all labor, sand, and equipment. Conoco will furnish all paint and necessary thinners.
- (5) This proposal and/or its provisions shall be incorporated into any forthcoming contract.
- (6) Consideration due to air pollution as a result of the sandblasting operation is not included in this proposal.

Slone Industrial Painters is fully covered with Bodily Injury and Property Damage insurance from \$100,000 to \$2,000,000 and Workmen's Compensation.

We are pleased to submit our proposal for painting two tanks located in Conoco's VCM Lake Charles, Louisiana plant site.

Scope of Work shall be the exterior surfaces of Tanks #T-450 and T-451. All piping and valves associated with these tanks and within the confines of the firewall are included.

SPECIFICATIONS:

- (1) Sandblast to SSPC-SP #6, commercial.
- (2) Apply two coats of Napko's Alkyd Primer.
- (3) Apply two coats of Napko's Alkyd Finish.

- NOTES:
1. All coats shall be applied at manufacturer's recommended millage.
 2. The galvanized stairways on these tanks shall receive a SSPC-SP #7 brush-off sandblast in lieu of the specified commercial grade.

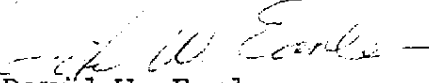
