Thank you for the information you sent me. I am having our analytical people, as well as NCR here in the states, evaluate it.

As far as the toxicological part of his report is concerned, he has confused and interchanged the experience on chlorinated biphenyl, chlorinated naphthalene, and a combination of both. This really is not too important, however, as there is no question but that Aroclor does possess a certain amount of toxicity. All our literature says this, but whether nanogram quantities mean anything is an entirely different matter.

I think we should fight the battle of the analytical method first before we get too involved with toxicology.
