A new crisis is shaping up in the Algerian war that may "internationalize" that bitter conflict.

Communist East Germany is organizing a "red foreign legion" to be sent to the aid of the Algerian rebels in their fight against the French.

It is in the cards that Santa Khrushchev will eventually extend recognition to the East German puppet government. According to reliable information he was warned by French President Charles de Gaulle when he bade farewell that there is any interference with economic relations to West Berlin, French tanks will flow into the former German capital.

The Soviet Union by refraining from active participation would not be threatened with retaliation which a war in Europe would entail.

'45 Ruse, Escape Told By Ex-Nazi

TEL AVIV, Israel, May 26 (AP)—Adolf Eichmann, former head of the German army, was captured by the U.S. Army after World War II but escaped recognition. The Israeli Security Service reported today that the service said Eichmann made the disclosure in a statement covering his activities between the collapse of the Third Reich in 1945 and his capture by British troops in 1946.

The service said Eichmann was in a prisoner of war camp—he thought that less interest would be taken in a private life than in a public one. The report said Eichmann later escaped from a prisoner of war camp.

A Security Service spokesman said the former chief of the Gestapo, Heinrich Himmler is reconciled to his fate and prepared to cooperate with his investigators. Eichmann's arrest was announced earlier this week, but the government refused to disclose the details of his capture, which climaxed a 15-year search.

The government is expected to seek the death penalty at Eichmann's trial as a war criminal. No trial date has been set.

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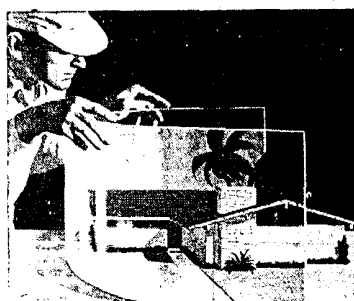

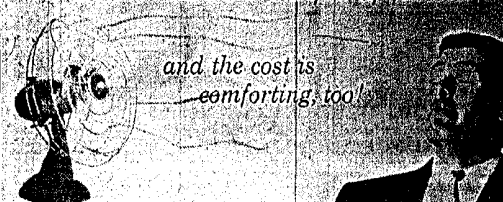
