**Tule river area
yields big catch
to trout anglers**

SAN FRANCISCO, May 10 (AP)—The south fork of the Tule river of the Porterville area was one of the favorite fishing locales the first few days of the open season, and catches per angler averaged from 12 to 17 trout, the State Division of Fish and Game reported today.

**Tigers collapse
