2	TS-5208(g)	Building 13 Employer failed to sample the air within the breathing zone of employees at this location, and at other locations, where operations produce or release asbestos dust into the air; and employer failed to establish a schedule of monitoring of the exposure of employees to levels of asbestos containing dust; and employer failed to make records of these exposure calculations available to the Division of Industrial Safety and to the employees or to their representatives.	9-30-73
