I am writing to inform you that the Compliance Assurance and Enforcement Division of Region 6, United States Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") has reviewed the information you provided in response to EPA's December 13, 2016 letter regarding potential Resource Conservation and Recovery Act ("RCRA") violations. Based on the July 18, 2017 meeting with ExxonMobil that detailed the facility's hazardous waste management, along with the written materials provided to EPA, EPA has determined no further action is required.

This letter does not constitute a decision as to your compliance with RCRA and does not limit EPA's ability to pursue additional investigations or issue enforcement actions relating to this event, or similar events, in the future.
