We have the following letter December 15 from the above:

"We acknowledge receipt of your cable reading:-

"REPLY NOVEMBER 29 SHIP AS MUCH BLUE ASBESTOS FIBRE AS IS
READY PLUS 25 TONS OF ORE AS FOLLOWS ON STEAMER SCHEDULED
TO ARRIVE AT U. S. PACIFIC OR GULF OR ATLANTIC."

We cabled our Mr. Powell in New York and asked him to advise
you that we had been able to obtain shipping space for 50
short tons of No. 3 Blue Fibre and 20 tons of ore on "Silver-
light" of Hough Knutsen Line due to sail from Fremantle direct
to New York on the 18th, instant. Should the ore not reach
Fremantle in time to catch the "Silverlight", the next oppor-
tunity will be the "John Bokke" sailing on or about the 7th
January, 1949.

Perth office will cable you as soon as the shipment is made
for insurance purposes and we have instructed them to draw a
sight draft on you through the Bank of New South Wales, Perth.
As the shipment is going direct to New York, all documents,
etc. will be forwarded to your New York office by our Perth
office.

We trust that these arrangements are satisfactory to you."
