Findings

This plant is designated as D in the general report and an appraisal of its dustiness is summarized in that column of Table 1. For reasons outlined in that report, the values for the preparation department are not considered truly representative of any one plant and, therefore, only approximate comparisons can be made.

Our own dust count in the carding room was materially lower than those in the company's files reported by the State in 1944, but we have given little weight to our values because they are single samples and therefore subject to sampling limitations.
