WHEREAS, THE CANADA METAL COMPANY LIMITED did by Agreement dated February 28, 1950, grant to THE CARTER WHITE LEAD COMPANY OF CANADA, LIMITED a non-exclusive, irrevocable, royalty-free license under Canadian Patent 491,507 (then Canadian Application S.N. 555,483) to make, use, and sell modified lead sulphate pigments for the full term of said Letters Patent; and

NOW, THEREFORE, this Indenture Witnesseth, that, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to it in hand paid by said NATIONAL LEAD COMPANY, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, said THE CANADA METAL COMPANY LIMITED has sold, assigned, transferred and set over and does hereby sell, assign, transfer and set over to said NATIONAL LEAD COMPANY, the aforesaid Letters Patent of the Dominion of Canada including the subject matter of any and all claims of said patent, the same to be held and enjoyed by

said NATIONAL LEAD COMPANY for its own use and behoof and for the use and behoof of its successors, assigns, or other legal representatives, to the end of the term for which said Letters Patent is granted, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by said THE CANADA METAL COMPANY LIMITED, as if this assignment and sale had not been made. Such sale, assignment, and transfer is subject to continuation of the license to THE CARTER WHITE LEAD COMPANY OF CANADA, LIMITED as aforementioned.

And said THE CANADA METAL COMPANY LIMITED hereby covenants that it has full right to convey the entire interest herein assigned and that it has not executed and will not execute any agreement to conflict herewith.
