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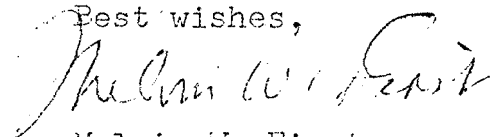

We have high hopes that the engineering modifications now underway will produce significant lowering of the lead content of Building "C" air. It would be of interest to obtain personal samples, as well as area samples, before and after, to evaluate exposures and improvements more precisely.
