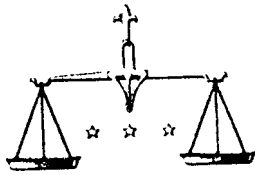

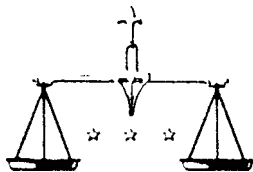

APPEARANCES: The claimant was represented by E. A. Massey, Esq. and Jay W. Jackson, Esq., 40 Russ Street, Hartford, Conn.; the respondents by their various representatives.

STIPULATION

A contract of employment was in force between Harry Haake, hereinafter referred to as the deceased, and the Armstrong Cork Company on

on or about June 6, 1957, and prior thereto, the deceased had been employed with the Insulation Company and Lotz Asbestos Company.

All of the aforesaid parties were subject to the provisions of the Compensation Act and the employers herein had complied therewith by insuring their compensation liability with the insurers set out in the caption hereof.

Pursuant to due and regular notice, informal hearings were held before the Compensation Commissioner for the First Congressional District on September 30, 1957 and November 27, 1957, when conferences were held between the parties in an attempt to compromise the entire case; thence postponed to July 20, 1959, when a further conference was held for this purpose.

At these conferences, it was the claimant's contention that the deceased had worked for many years with the employers herein, installing asbestos insulating materials; that, as a result thereof, he contracted an occupational disease, to wit: asbestosis; that he became disabled therefrom on or about June 6, 1957 and remained so disabled until his death on October 14, 1957.

Alleging that the deceased's disability and death arose out of and in the course of his employment with the employers herein, the claimant, as dependent widow, sought compensation for the disability and death of the deceased together with payment of all the reasonable medical, surgical and hospital bills that had been incurred, and the burial expense, as allowed by law.

The respondents, however, denied that the deceased had sustained any occupational disease that arose out of and in the course of his employment with the employers herein. The respondents further contended that the entire claim was barred by reason of the statute of limitations. The respondents further contended that the deceased's disability and death was due to an acute coronary occlusion and other causes unconnected with his employment with the employers herein. In any event, the respondents denied that the claimant's lung condition played a material part in his disability and death.

However, in view of the number of technical, legal and medical questions that were involved, and in view of the other doubts in the case, as outlined by the claims of the parties hereto, it is hereby agreed and understood by and between the claimant, the employers and insurers herein, all parties to the controversy, that while their respective claims are made in good faith, the claim is a disputed one and that its results, if fully prosecuted, would be doubtful.

WHEREFORE, it is agreed by and between the parties hereto that the respondents shall pay to the claimant the sum of Three Thousand Three Hundred Sixty-three Dollars and Sixty Cents (\$3363.60), the same to be in full, final and complete settlement, adjustment, accord and satisfaction of all claims which the aforesaid claimant might otherwise have against the respondents, or any of them, and to be made and accepted in lieu of all other compensation payments, in accordance with the language of our act.

It is hereby agreed and understood that said settlement of Three Thousand Three Hundred Sixty-three Dollars and Sixty Cents (\$3363.60) shall be divided and apportioned among the respondents herein as follows, to wit:

It is specifically understood and agreed that said settlement of Three Thousand Three Hundred Sixty-three Dollars and Sixty Cents (3363.60) represents a settlement of \$1500.00 to the claimant, plus payment of the following bills, to wit: St. Francis Hospital - \$983.60, Dr. Hennessy - \$410.00, Dr. Bowen - \$110.00, Dr. Danyliw - \$55.00, and Dr. DeRoche - \$305.00; and that all of the aforesaid bills shall be paid by the claimant out of the proceeds of this total settlement.

The payment of said sum of Three Thousand Three Hundred Sixty-three Dollars and Sixty Cents (\$3363.60) shall be made and accepted as a full and final settlement for all compensation for the disability and death of the deceased and for all claims for medical, surgical, hospital and funeral expenses to the end that the payment of such sum shall constitute a complete satisfaction of all claims due or to become due at any time in favor of anybody on account of the disability and death of the deceased.

It is expressly understood and agreed that the payment of said sum of Three Thousand Three Hundred Sixty-three Dollars and Sixty Cents is in full accord and satisfaction of a disputed claim and is not an admission of any liability by the respondents, or any of them.

It is further stipulated and agreed that, before the claimant signed this stipulation, she read it, or the same was read and interpreted to her in a language that she understands and she knows that it is a full and final settlement and that it is intended to deal with any and all conditions, known or unknown, which exist as of the date hereof, or any changes of conditions which may arise in the future on account of the disability and death of the deceased.

It is further agreed by and between the parties that this stipulation was not induced or entered into by fraud, accident, mistake or duress and that none of the parties hereafter shall have any further claims under the Workmen's Compensation Act of the State of Connecticut.

IN VIEW OF THE FOREGOING, We, the undersigned, hereby unite in requesting that the Compensation Commissioner for the First Congressional District approve this stipulation.
