Gentlemen:

Please be advised that the result of the chest x-ray examination of your employees on October 8, 1951, by the Industrial Hygiene Division of the State Health Department, disclosed that Harry E. Chase of Montgomery Center and Chester R. Moody of Morrisville, were the only employees found to be affected by some degree of asbestosis. They can safely be employed in such hazardous employment as long as adequate dust control is provided.

If you desire to ask for a waiver on these employees please notify this office and we will notify each employee as to his condition. A copy of such notice will be sent to you and upon receipt of same you may proceed to obtain the waiver.
