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My feeling on asbestos remains the same; I want to continue to provide an asbestos Ready-Mix as long as possible. In the meantime, continue development on the asbestos free product we currently have available. I would expect the government to require an asbestos free product on federal jobs. If this transpires, we do have a product we can furnish.

I am very anxious to finalize the asbestos free casein project. As soon as we can introduce our asbestos free casein, I plan a price increase on all bag goods from Chicago, casein and vinyl.
