I could follow some presentations that I found very interesting. I am happy to see that progress has been made and that the recent larger tests provided good results.

I'd like to know if the presentations will be published on Lastfire's website. They contain very important learnings worth sharing to a wider audience to advance the experience exchange and speed up the transition from PFAS-based foams.

I would also be interested in having your feedback on these recent encouraging developments in relation with the (still long) transitional periods requested by the oil and petrochemical industry. In other words, can't the transition be fully and safely implemented before 10 years' time for the most critical uses (that I would define as 'uses by Seveso establishments' since narrowing to LAST might be too restrictive).
