

1 they do pay user fees for that access, where the
2 members receive many of the library services free of
3 charge as part of their membership benefit.

4 Q. How long has the library been open to the
5 public with those qualifications?

6 A. The library had been in existence, based on
7 my research, since 1915. According to further
8 research, it appears the library was open to the
9 public, I would say, in the late 1919s or early
10 1920s. The council was formed in 1913.

11 Q. Sir, in your position as reference
12 librarian, can you tell us your familiarity with the
13 publications that are published by the NSC itself?

14 A. I am very familiar with many of the
15 publications put out by the NSC, just for the fact
16 that master copies are housed in our library in our
17 archives.

18 Q. How does that -- is that part of your
19 duties, to handle those published materials by the
20 NSC and to archive them?

21 A. Yes. Part of my duties as -- the library
22 also acts as a repository for NSC-published
23 materials.
