SUBJECT PACO #5525 TAPING COMPOUND WITH ASBESTOS

I have 239 bags of #5525B Taping Compound at San Carlos that contains asbestos. This material is substandard, because the asbestos was pressure-packed and did not disperse completely, leaving dark specks of asbestos that showed up when it was used. The branch cost is \$2.24/bag.

The law allows the sale of patching compounds until June 12, 1978, but prohibits the manufacture or shipment from the manufacturer after January 16, 1978, except for industrial use.
