

Murder Preliminary Scheduled Tomorrow

Preliminary examination of Theodore Roosevelt Duty, 37, dishwasher of 1191 36th Street, for the murder of a Richmond ex-convict will be held at 9 a.m. Friday, April 21, in Municipal Court.

Duty, in custody in City prison, was charged Monday with the shotgun slaying of Fred Cotton, 41, of 1624 Sixth Street, Richmond, who was on parole from Fort Leavenworth on a Mann Act conviction.

Nordhoff was convicted in Los Angeles County in 1922 for robbery and was imprisoned at San Quentin until 1934.

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
