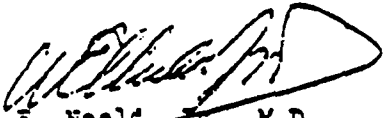

PULMONARY FUNCTION STUDIES

In response to Plant Manager Dr. J. L. Richmond's letter of June 20, 1966, the Medical Division is participating in a combined program with the Process Department in attempts to obtain information and control relative to certain alleged air contaminants or pollutants.
