ECOS is holding a national webinar on September 26 on Cooperative Federalism 2.0. We invited our mailing list to the webinar to learn about the effort and currently have approximately 80 participants signed up but I expect we will reach over 100. The participants will come from business, NGOs, EPA staff, state agency staff, other Federal agencies, and the press.

Given that this will be a very public presentation of cooperative federalism 2.0 and will give insight into the work states are doing with EPA, I want to make sure we are on the same page with you and that you are comfortable with what ECOS will present.

I am confident that we will be asked by webinar attendees how they can get engaged in this effort and I'd like to work with you on what response is most appropriate. ECOS is thinking that we would offer a webinar every two months to provide updates.

Also if one of you (or another EPA senior leader) would like to make some comments from EPA during the webinar that is an option and could be strategically valuable.

I suggest we have a call about this later today.
