It has now almost been a year since our fruitful meeting in Helsinki with you and your team. Developments around chemical management rules have evolved and progressed. We very much appreciate the dialogue which we started last year and would like to continue it. Developments that have kept our attention since last year include the One-Substance-One-Assessment new proposals, the new grouping assessments made in ARNs and in the PVC Investigation report, the progress on the PFAS restriction process for which we submitted data in the open public consultation, and discussions on substitution and how to work on alternatives.
