Mr. Kellogg of the Yonkers laboratory suggested that I write to you for answers to my questions, in regard to burning leaded gasoline in my camp cook stove.

Is it dangerous to burn leaded gas in a camping cook stove - aside from clogging the generator which can be cleaned frequently? Are fumes given off that would harm a person using the stove?

Could the lead be inexpensively filtered out?

The Kamp-Cook stove claims to have a filter attachment on the generator but they are not available yet.

In travelling from place to place it is almost impossible to get "clear" gas. Any assistance will be deeply appreciated.
